Louisville Regional Science Fairs: Joanna Tarullo, 8th Grade, St. Francis of Assisi School, "Does the Additive of Antioxidants Affect Biodiesel?" Teacher: Fred Whittaker. Category: Chemistry. Joanna won this award last year but she carried her project much further this year and was the best automotive project in our opinions.

duPont Manual High School Regional Science Fairs: Manpreet "Sahiba" Chopra, 10th grade, "A Comparison of the Effects of the Exhaust from Biodiesel and Diesel Fuels on Cytokines Secreted by Macrophage Cell Lines." Teacher: Bill Deines. Category: Medicine & Health.

Calendar of Upcoming Events

The next scheduled event is April 11th, 2009. The Bluegrass Stars section will conduct a drive from two starting locations (New Albany and Corydon, Indiana), to Mt. The Louisville contingent will meet at I-64 exit 123, at the corner of Spring and State Streets in New Albany, Indiana, to depart at 8 AM. We will take I-64 west approx. 18 miles to Corydon and stop at exit 105 to pick up the Elizabethtown / Radcliff contingent, which will meet us at 8:30 AM. We will all then convoy together 100 miles on I-64 west to exit 4 (Griffin). Take Route 69 south past New Harmony for ~17 miles to an intersection where route 69 takes a hard left turn. Continue straight for 2 more miles on Main St. to Courthouse Square. Turn left onto E. 4th Street (IN 62/69) for ¾ mile. Park in the McDonald's paved

lot across the street from Gerton Auto Sales at 1024 E. 4th Street. Total distance from New Albany to Mt. Vernon is ~140 miles.


